Match Reports:

13B v Banksia Tigers

Drew 1 - 1

Goal Scorer: Saul

As we get later into the season, the wear on a lot of grounds is starting to show: in the beautiful surrounds of Gardiner Park, the pitch was basically dirt through the middle with a little bit of grass on the wings. School holidays is a tricky time: apart from those away on holidays, we were well down on numbers at training this week and it showed on the field, when in the Tigers' first foray into our half we lost control of the ball despite having 3 players on the spot, and from the resulting throw in Banksia took advantage of some indecision from our keeper to go ahead. We then camped out in their half for most of the rest of the game without really looking very threatening, as far too often we were flat footed and tried passes that were easily cut off by Banksia, who sat back and were happy to boot out any ball that came near them. The Tigers keeper did a good job getting down to a narrow shot from Saul in the 20th minute after he had scrambled well in a chase down the sideline, but apart from that, our other shots were - along with our teamwork - well off target.

In the second half, Banksia continued to take time out of the game with tactics like taking ages for their goal kicks, and almost caught us a couple of times on the counter as our defenders pushed up high and sometimes out of position, but their first touch was generally too heavy and our defenders got back to cover. 80% of the play was in still in our attacking half, and in the 47th minute, after a number of corners in succession, the Banksia players felt the ball had gone over the base line. With no call from the referee, however, it came back to Andrei who put in a high cross that Saul met with a great header to finally equalise at 1-all. Another 50/50 no-call from the referee shortly after meant their keeper was forced into a good reflex save, as he palmed a shot wide. The Tigers had another call go against them as their striker was called offside when standing on the half way line as the ball was passed, but the line markings weren't very clear on the ground at all, and from the referee's position visibility would have been a guess anyway; in any event, Zane had it covered. Full time arrived with no change to the 1-1 scoreline.

Overall, this was a very disappointing game, and gives Scots a 4 point buffer at the top of the table, so even if we beat them in round 17, they will finish as minor premiers unless they slip up in one of the other games, so a draw against them in the finals will not be enough; there are plenty of things to work on between now and then, though.
